6.03 SIDEWALKS

(1) WIDTH. The width of all artificial sidewalks hereafter to be constructed, laid or re-laid in the City of Fountain City shall be as follows: On Main Street between North and Spring Streets; on Front Street between North and Eagle Streets; On North Street between Front and Main Streets, and on Liberty Street between Front and Main Streets they shall be eight feet wide. On Front Street from the North West Corner of Block No. fourteen (14) in the Plat of Fountain City to the Western limits of said city, the same shall be five feet wide; On all other street or parts of streets within the limits of said city the sidewalks shall be six feet wide.

(2) GRADE. All sidewalks in said city hereafter to be constructed, laid or re-laid shall be laid and constructed according to the accepted and established grade of said city, as shown by the city survey and profiles of the established grade lines, on file in the office of the city clerk of said city.

(3) MATERIAL. All artificial sidewalks which may hereafter be constructed, laid or re-laid in the city of Fountain City, shall be of cement, cement blocks, cement concrete, or stone, and no other material of any kind or nature shall be used for sidewalks upon the streets of said city.

(4) SUPERVISION. All sidewalks which shall hereafter be constructed, laid or relaid in the city of Fountain City shall be constructed, laid or relaid under the superintendence and direction of the street committee of the common council of said city.

(5) GRADE AND LINE. No person shall construct, lay or relay any sidewalks in said city without first procuring from the street committee of the common council of said city the grade and line upon which such walk shall be laid, and it shall be the duty of the said street committee to furnish such grade and line without charge therefore.

(6) REPAIR. After any sidewalk has been laid or curbing set, if the same, or any portion thereof shall get out of repair, or shall settle below the proper grade, it shall be the duty of the owner of the premises abutting such sidewalk or curbing to repair, relay or reset the same under the direction of and in the manner required by the street committee of the common council of said city.

(7) PUBLIC AND PRIVATE CROSSINGS-MATERIAL. Public or private crossings which may hereafter be constructed, laid or relaid in the city of Fountain City upon or across the streets of said city, shall be of cement, cement blocks, vetrified brick, cement concrete, or stone, and no other material of any kind or nature shall be used for public or private crossings upon the streets of said city.

(8) REMOVAL OF SNOW.

(a) Duty to Remove. It is hereby made the duty of the owner of any building, or lot of land, bordering on any street in said city of Fountain City, where there is a side-walk, to remove the snow from such side-walk, within twelve hours after it has ceased to snow, or cause the same to be removed within that time, at his expense.

(b) Failure to remove. In case such owner shall neglect or fail to remove the snow as herein provided, it shall be the duty of the street commissioner to remove the same forthwith, at the expense of such owner.

(c) Expense of removal-Collection. The street commissioner shall remove the snow from the side-walks fronting on the streets of said city, from all lots whose owner neglects or fails to remove the snow, or causes the same to be removed, within the time limited in section (a), and shall return the amount charged for such work, under oath, to the city clerk, who shall insert the same in the next tax roll of said city, in the same manner as provided by the city charter for the returns and insertion of delinquent side-walk taxes.
