

WHAT'S NEW FOR RECYLING IN 2019

- Recycling collection will be done as a Single Stream Recycling System - meaning they *don't* have to be separated.
- Single stream saves time, reduces costs, saves natural resources.
- All recyclables should be placed loosely into the bin or cart.

Recycling bins and carts are provided by and owned by Waste Transport. Carts and bins should be placed on curbside by 7:00 a.m. on pickup day. Replacement costs for lost, stolen or broken bins or carts are the responsibility of the property owner at current cost. Curbside pickup days are every other Wednesday beginning January 9 with one exception – last pickup day will be *Thursday, December 26*.

WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

Plastics

- #1, 2, 4 & 5 Plastic containers
- Yogurt cups, ketchup/mustard bottles
- Tubs, bottles, jugs, detergent containers

Glass Jars and Bottles of any color

Cardboard/Paper

- Newspapers, shiny inserts (*place loose in bin/cart if it fits -OR- bundle & tie and place next to bin/cart*)
- Magazines and catalogs
- Any type of corrugated boxes (*place loose in bin/cart if it fits -OR- bundle & tie and place next to bin/cart*)
- Pressed paper and office paper
- Soda, pizza (unsoiled), and beer boxes
- Egg cartons and phone books
- Mail, junk mail, and envelopes (plastic windows are ok)
- Cereal, cracker, and snack boxes
- Toothpaste, soap, and detergent boxes
- Cards, gift wrap (no tissue or foil paper)
- Shredded paper (place in paper bag)

Cartons - Food and Beverage

- Milk cartons (dairy, soy, almond)
- Juice, soup, broth & wine cartons

Metals

- Aluminum, tin steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans, empty paint cans/lids
- Aluminum foil, pie plates, containers (cannot be soiled with food)
- Wire clothes hangers
- Christmas lights, extension cords, electrical wiring (no coaxial cable)
- Metal pots and pans

WHAT IS NOT RECYCLABLE?

- Garbage
- Food waste
- Plastic bags or film
- Food-tainted items
- Ceramics & dishware
- Plastic wrap
- Windows & mirrors
- Packing peanuts or bubble wrap
- Photographs
- Medical waste
- Polystyrene or Styrofoam
- Hazardous chemical containers
- Plastic toys or sporting goods
- Foam egg cartons
- Wood
- Light bulbs
- Yard waste

REMINDERS

Recyclables should be set out in bins/carts provided by Waste Transport. If you need an additional bin/cart, please contact Waste Transport at 608-248-3322.

Plastic bags are not recyclable and should not be used to bag recyclable items.

If you are NOT using recycling bins/carts, please contact Waste Transport at 608-248-3322 to arrange for pickup.

****Placing recycling bins/carts on the sidewalk or curb longer than 24 hours prior to pickup is in violation of the recycling ordinance. The penalty for violation is \$75.00 first violation, \$150.00 second violation, and up to \$2,000 third or subsequent violation.**

RECYCLING CENTER TIPPING FEES

The on-site attendant will collect fees and issue receipts.

Items can be dropped off only during open hours.

Dumping items outside of gate is prohibited and subject to fines.

GARBAGE PICKUP

Garbage pickup is every Wednesday beginning January 2 with one exception – last pickup day will be *Thursday, December 26*. Garbage bags should be placed on curbside by 7:00 a.m. on pickup day. Waste Transport garbage bags are available for purchase at City Hall and Kwik Trip. Regular bags are not acceptable.

****Placing garbage out on the sidewalk or curb longer than 24 hours prior to pickup is in violation of city ordinance. The penalty for violation is \$75.00 first violation, \$150.00 second violation, and up to \$2,000 third or subsequent violation.**

Taxes – Taxes are due January 31, 2019 payable to the City of Fountain City. The second installment is due July 31, 2019 payable to the County Treasurer. Taxes may be paid in person beginning December 17, 2018 at the Clerk-Treasurer's office, may be mailed or placed in the depository slot next to the door of City Hall. Tax roll listings will be available upon request after January 2, 2019.

Christmas Trees – Place trees curbside the week of January 7. They will be picked up by the public works staff.

Building Permits – Building permits are required for improvements valued at over \$500 including any building or structure, and any enlargement, alteration, heating or ventilation installation, moving or demolishing, or anything affecting the fire hazards or safety of any building or structure. Permit applications can be picked up at City Hall or on the city website.

Dog Licenses – Dogs must be licensed annually by April 1st. Proof of rabies vaccination must be included with the application. Fees are as follows: male or female \$15, spayed or neutered \$10. Applications can be picked up at City Hall or on the city website. *Pets must be on a leash when not on the premises of the owner. Any animal excrement deposited on property other than the owner must be picked up immediately and disposed of properly.*

Burning Permits – Burning permits are available for brush type material only. Fee is \$3. Permits can be obtained by contacting the Fire Chief. Recreational backyard campfires are allowed when using a campfire ring or like container.

Parking - Parking in Excess of 48 hours Prohibited. No person shall park any vehicle on any City Street or City Parking Lot or on any other public or private property within the City Limits, without the permission of the owner of such property, for more than Forty-Eight (48) consecutive hours. Violations are subject to towing and fines.

Junk Vehicles – Junked motor vehicles and nuisance vehicles are prohibited on property within the City Limits of the City of Fountain City, Wisconsin unless located within a fully enclosed building. Violations are subject to fines.
